Eligibility Requirements (Membership is based on Scholarship, Character, and Service):

- All Juniors and Seniors who are currently enrolled in a regents level science or higher and have completed two years of high school regents level science. Any student who has demonstrated exceptional scientific talents by the science department.
- Students must have a minimum science scholarship average of 90%, an overall scholastic average of at least 85%, and a minimum mathematics average of 80%.
- Students must be enrolled in a regent's level science course or higher.
- Students must participate in at least two sustained, ongoing chapter activities above and beyond the science classroom experience. These may include but are not limited to, organized peer tutoring, participating as a member of the High School Science Olympiad Team, fundraising activities, and promoting scientific interest in the district youth through a local science fair or science club, or performing research at a laboratory or university.
- Each student must submit two faculty recommendation forms. These forms should also supply the teacher with an envelope for the forms and are responsible for turning in the recommendations with their complete application.
- Student must submit the **most recent transcript** for grade verification and class enrollment from guidance with application.
