The Huntington Arts-In-Education Committee, in conjunction with the PTA, is pleased to present **Danza Espanol** by the **Sol y Sombra Dance Company**.

Danza Espanol, performed in colorful traditional costuming, combines Spanish classical, folk, and Flamenco Dance with simple lecture linking the dances to the multicultural development of the Spanish language and culture. Using grade appropriate language, references are made to the ancient Greek and Roman civilizations of the Mediterranean, the Arabs and Moors, the Africans, the Sephardim Jews, the Gypsies from India, as well as native American Indians and various Latin/South American countries and cultures.

The program includes audience participation with students learning how to express rhythm in their body arm and hand movements, hand clapping and footwork. The program culminates with students on stage learning a short choreography with the artists.
