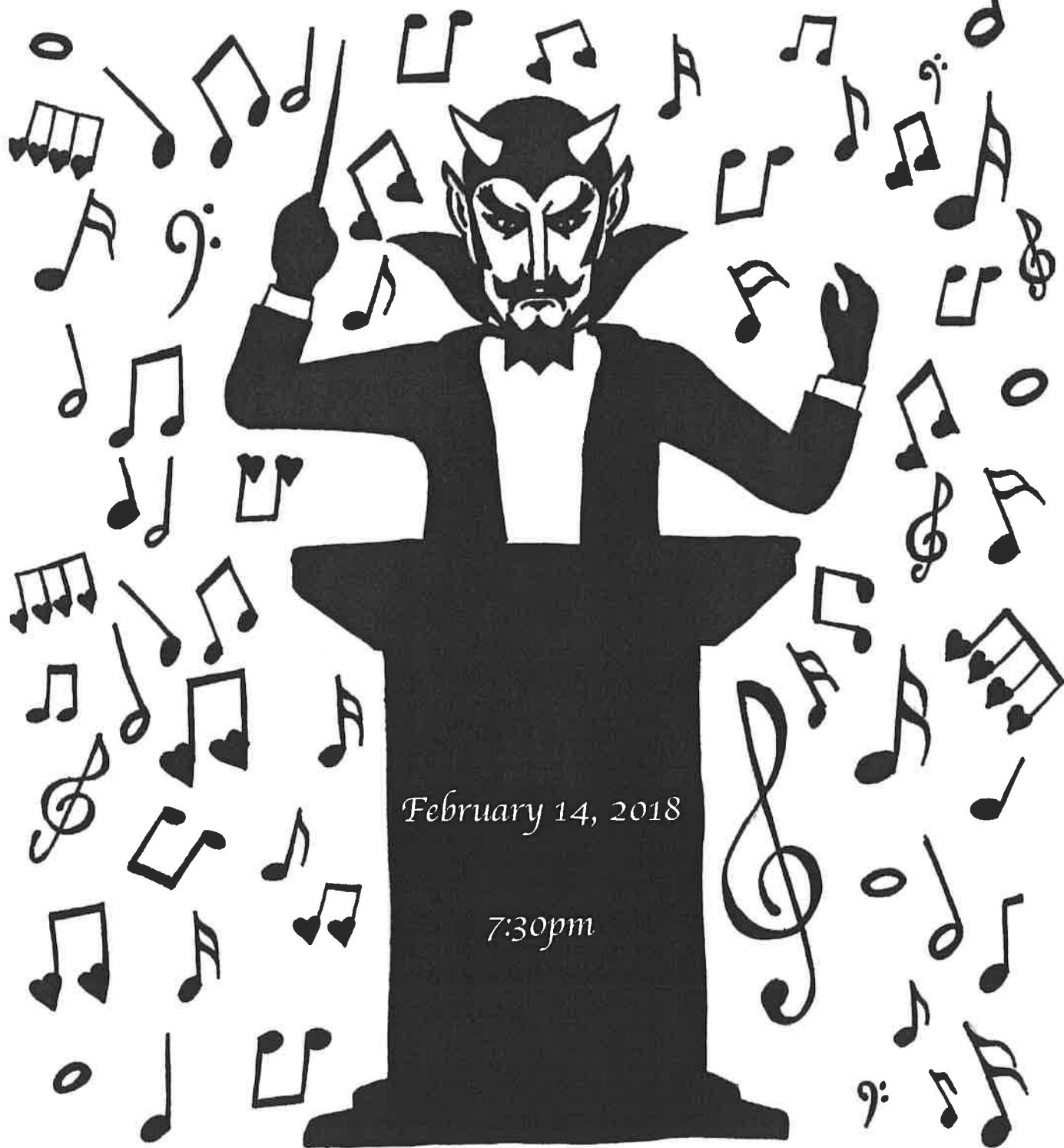

Senior Band Program Notes

Sang!.....Dana Wilson (b. 1946)

In *Sang!*, Wilson uses a wonderful crossover style focused on minimalism and jazz, with rhythmic vocalizations from the players for an added twist. The piece is built of phrases that are repeated over and over throughout, but in various combinations to provide interest and growth.

Sleep.....Eric Whitacre (b. 1970)

Sleep began its life as an a cappella choral setting with a magnificent original poem by Charles Anthony Silvestri. The chorale-like nature and warm harmonies seemed to call out for the simple and plaintive sound of winds, and I thought that it might make a gorgeous addition to the wind symphony repertoire. -Eric Whitacre

The *Star Wars* soundtrack is arguably one of the greatest film scores ever written. The saga began in 1977 with *Episode IV: A New Hope* and has continued to produce eight movies in total with a ninth currently in production. *The Empire Strikes Back* premiered in 1980 and is the fifth in the *Star Wars* series.

John Williams has composed the music for nearly 80 films including *Jaws*, *Schindler's List*, *E.T.: The Extra-Terrestrial*, *Saving Private Ryan*, *Jurassic Park*, *Hook*, *Indiana Jones*, *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*, and *Superman*.

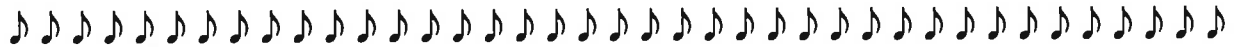
